

Safety Toolbox Talks

A CONFINED SPACE:

- IS LARGE ENOUGH AND SO CONFIGURED THAT A WORKER CAN BODILY ENTER AND PERFORM ASSIGNED WORK: **AND**
- HAS LIMITED OR RESTRICTED MEANS FOR ENTRY AND EXIT (FOR EXAMPLE, TANKS, VESSELS, SILOS, STORAGE BINS, HOPPERS, VAULTS, AND PITS ARE SPACES THAT MAY HAVE LIMITED MEANS OF ENTRY); **AND**
- IS NOT DESIGNED FOR CONTINUOUS WORKER OCCUPANCY.

A CONFINED SPACE CAN EITHER BE NON-PERMIT CONFINED SPACE OR A PERMIT REQUIRED CONFINED SPACE.

NON-PERMIT CONFINED SPACE IS A CONFINED SPACE THAT DOES NOT CONTAIN OR, WITH RESPECT TO ATMOSPHERIC HAZARDS, HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO CONTAIN ANY HAZARD CAPABLE OF CAUSING DEATH OR SERIOUS PHYSICAL HARM.

PERMIT-REQUIRED CONFINED SPACE (PERMIT SPACE) IS A CONFINED SPACE THAT HAS **ONE OR MORE** OF THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS:

- CONTAINS OR HAS A POTENTIAL TO CONTAIN A HAZARDOUS ATMOSPHERE;
- CONTAINS A MATERIAL THAT HAS THE POTENTIAL FOR ENGULFING AN ENTRANT;
- HAS AN INTERNAL CONFIGURATION SUCH THAT AN ENTRANT COULD BE TRAPPED OR ASPHYXIATED BY INWARDLY CONVERGING WALLS OR BY A FLOOR WHICH SLOPES DOWNWARD AND TAPERS TO A SMALLER CROSS SECTION; OR
- CONTAINS ANY OTHER RECOGNIZED SERIOUS SAFETY OR HEALTH HAZARD.

BRIESER CONSTRUCTION HAS A PERMIT REQUIRED CONFINED SPACE PROGRAM. BE SURE THE CONFINED SPACE HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BEFORE ENTERING. IF THE SPACE IS DESIGNATED AS A PERMIT REQUIRED CONFINED SPACE. BE SURE YOU HAVE BEEN ADEQUATELY TRAINED AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF OUR PROGRAM ARE BEING FOLLOWED.
